School Uniform Policy - Whalton C of E Primary School

Rationale:

We believe that uniform promotes the ethos of our school, provides a sense of belonging and identity, and sets an appropriate tone for education. It is important that children wear the correct uniform.

However, we recognise that the cost of our school uniform needs to be reasonable and secures the best value for money for parents/carers. We do this by following the guidance under the <u>Education</u> (<u>Guidance about Costs of School Uniforms</u>) Act 2021.

Our Uniform Expectations:

- Grey Blazer (optional school logo also optional)
- Red V-neck knitted jumper/cardigan (required school logo optional)
- Tie clip on, elasticated or standard (required)
- White shirt
- Grey trousers/skirt/shorts
- Sensible black shoes
- Grey/black/white socks or tights
- Red check/stripe dress (summer term)
- Plain black school shoes (no sandals or trainers, boots not to be worn indoors)

P.E.

- Black/Navy shorts
- Plain black/navy joggers(winter term)
- Plain White or red round neck T-shirt
- School Hoodie with logo optional for sport and sporting events or a plain red sweatshirt
- Black sand shoes (optional for in school) / trainers (for outside)
- Swimming costume

Additional items:

Named wellington boots for outdoor activities

^{*}All children are asked to come to school in their PE kits on PE days

 All uniform, PE kits, bags, coats, shoes and wellies need to be clearly labelled with the child's name. Items can be acquired with the school logo but it is not compulsory for all uniform to be branded.

- For hygiene/safety reasons, long hair should be tied back
- Bookbags are available with the school logo these are provided by school in the Reception year free of charge, with choice of school tie

Governors

The Governing Body will review this policy and make sure that it:

- Is appropriate for our school's context
- Is implemented fairly across the school
- Takes into account the views of parents and pupils
- Offers a uniform that is appropriate, practical and safe for all pupils

The Governing Body will also make sure that the school's uniform supplier arrangements give the highest priority to cost and value for money, for example by avoiding single supplier contracts and by re-tendering contracts at least every 5 years.

Monitoring arrangements

This policy will be reviewed by the Executive Headteacher and approved every four years by the Governing Body.
